Common warts are small, raised growths that are rough to the touch and occur most often on the hands, elbows and knees. Common warts are caused by a virus. They are transmitted through touch and can take months to years to resolve.

Right now dermatologists at selected centers in the U.S. are accepting participants for a new clinical research study for an investigational topical gel for warts. If you or your child are 8 years of age or older and have one to six warts you may qualify to participate.

If you qualify you will receive all study-related care and medication at no cost. You may receive compensation for your time and travel to attend study visits.
